



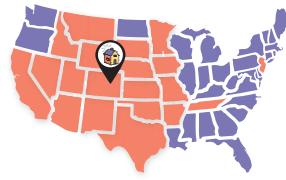
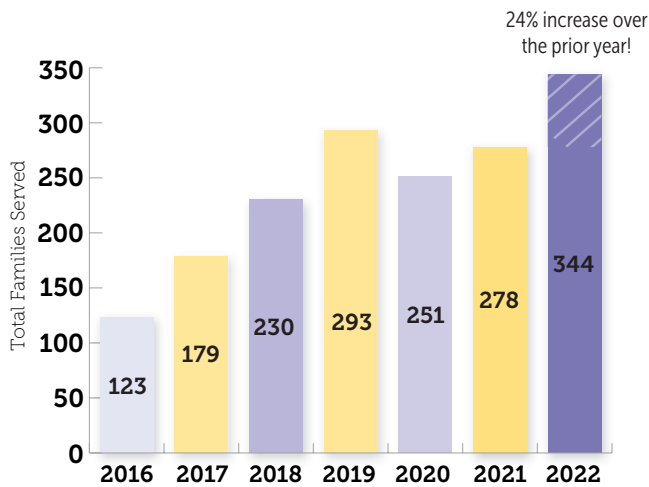

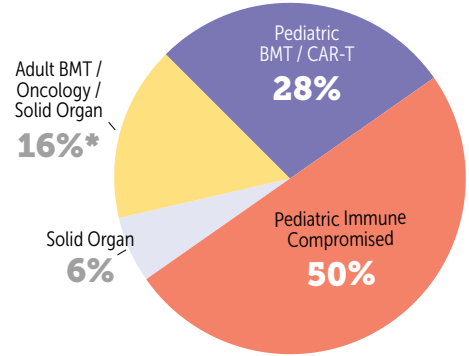
## Aurora Campus

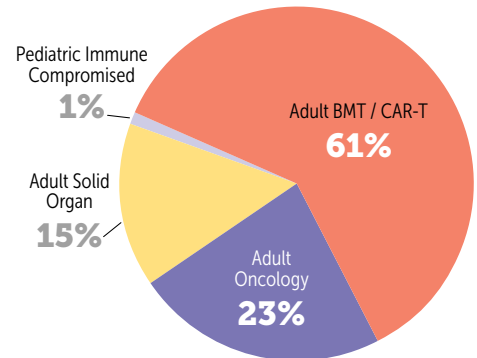
## The Forum Fitzsimons

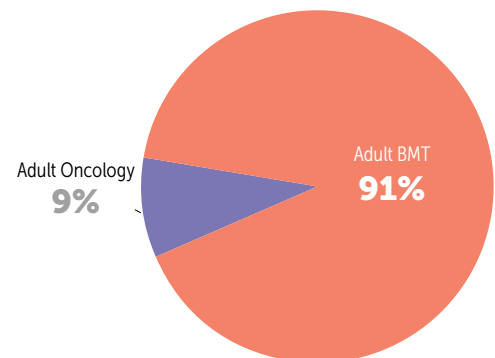
## Park 17

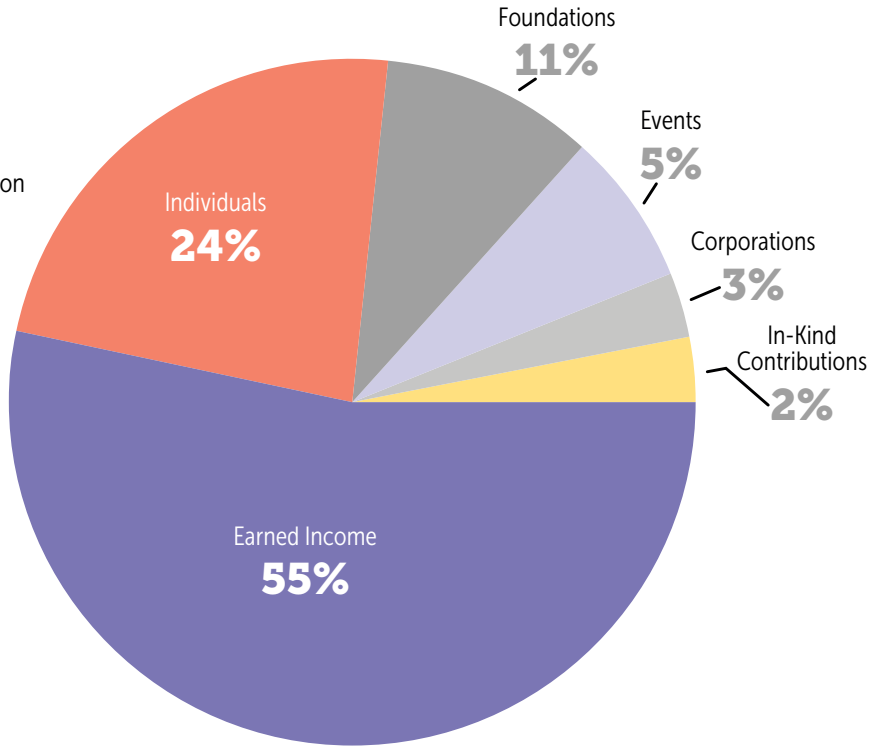

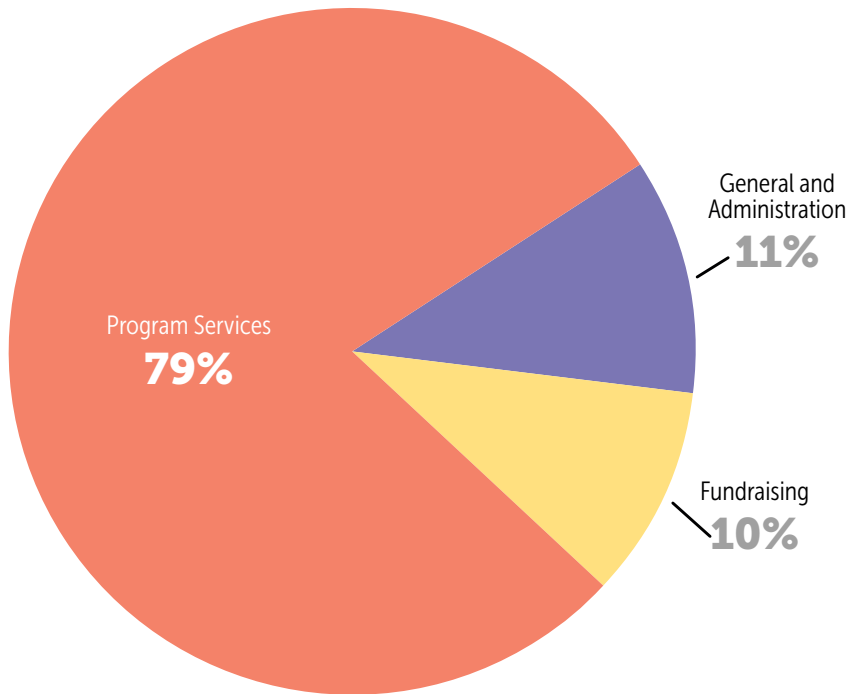
## Operating Revenue
